2) They are sealed in their ministry by the Spirit of God (vs. 1d)

3) They are selected for a unique responsibility (see chapter 7)

4) They are separated from the pollution of the world (vs.4a)

(2 Corinthians 11:2; James 4:4)

5) They will serve the Lord with all their strength (vs. 4b)

(Isaiah 42:6-7; Isaiah 49:6)

IV. THE PRAISE OF THE VISION-The song of the 144,000 (vs. 2-3)
