As we enter into the final chapters of the Book of Revelation we see some last things in the last days in chapter 14...

**I. THE LAST PREACHERS OF THE GOSPEL**  
(vss. 6, 8, 9, 15, 17, 18)

Revelation 14:6-20 can be organized around John's vision of six angels. (14:6a; 14:8a; 14:9a; 14:15a; 14:17a; 14:18a)

Throughout the words of the Scriptures and this prophecy we see a gracious and merciful God who has tried to put every roadblock in man's path to keep him from an eternity in Hell.

How has man spurned the grace of Almighty God?

From the beginning man spurned...

1-The God of creation and conscience  
(Romans 1:18-19)

2-The Torah (The Law of God)  
(Deuteronomy 11:26-28)

3-The prophets of old  
(Luke 13:34)

4-The Lord Jesus Christ  
(John 3:16-17)

5- Preachers throughout the ages

After the rapture of the church God will use...

6-The 144,000 of Revelation 7 and 14

7-The mighty angel of Revelation 10  
(10:7; 11:15)

8-The two witnesses of Revelation 11  
(11:3)

9-The 6 angels dispatched from  
Heaven in Revelation 14

These angels will be the last preachers to preach to  
mankind!

What does this say about our God?

Throughout the ages our God has been, is, and will  
be a God of grace and mercy...giving man every  
opportunity to repent! But there is coming a day  
when man will hear his last message from the last  
messengers of God...and it will be too late!

## II. THE LAST MESSAGE FROM HEAVEN (14:6-10a, 14-20)

What will be God's final message through these angels  
to a lost and unrepentant world?

1-The declaration of the gospel (vs. 6-7)  
(Matthew 24:14; Hebrews 11:6)

2-The downfall of Babylon (vs. 8)  
(Revelation 14:8)

3-The doom of the compromisers  
(vs. 9-10a, 11b)  
(Revelation 14:9-10a)

4-The divine King of all Kings (vs. 14)  
(Matthew 13:36-43; Matthew 13:47-50)

5-The destruction of God's wrath  
(vs. 15-20)  
(Joel 3:11-16; Revelation 19:14-15)

## III. THE LAST DESTINY OF ALL MANKIND (vs. 10b-13)

When all is said and done there are only two destinies  
for every man and woman both today and at the time  
of the tribulation.

1-The destiny of the lost (14:10b-11a)

2-The destiny of the saved (14:12-13)  
(Matthew 11:28)

If you were to take your last breath right now would  
you be lost or saved?
